
Dear Mr. Harmon,

The change in our climate has impacted our traditional subsistence lifestyle greatly. This is in fact the first year I've noticed that meat racks are bare. Seal oil to preserve our food had to be shipped in from mainland, as hunting the for seals and walrus was poor. We depend on the ocean for food we preserve and store to sustain us throughout seasons ahead.

On behalf of the Native Village of Diomed and all residents, we would like to send our sincere gratitude and high-5s for the generous donation of fish to our Inupiaq hometown. Your charity will bring goodness to our dinner tables. Once again, we extend our heartfelt thanks, from Little Diomed, Alaska to you!
