2012 PETER PAN FLEET COOP REPORT:

1.0 Introduction:

The 2012 Peter Pan Fleet Co-Op was allocated 12,417 mt of the Inshore component of the BSAI 2012 pollock TAC.

The individual catcher vessels belonging to the PP Fleet CoOp were given individual percentages of the Co-Op's allocation based on (confirmed by NMFS) historical catch brought to the PP Fleet CoOp.

This is showed in Table 1-A.

Using information on historical catch history percentages, table 1-B shows you how pollock allocations were given for the entire year.
