## 2022 PETER PAN FLEET COOP REPORT:

### 1.0 Introduction:

The 2023 Peter Pan Fleet Co-Op was initially allocated 8,307 mt of the Inshore component of the BSAI 2023 pollock TAC. March 17th 2023, there was AI Rollover for A Season allocated to the vessels. Another allocation increase happened for AI Rollover for B Season.

The individual catcher vessels belonging to the PP Fleet CoOp were given individual percentages of the Co-Op's allocation. See Table 1-A.
