NOAA Fisheries' Alaska Regional Office is responsible for working with the North Pacific Fishery Management Council to develop and implement management measures for federally-managed commercial and recreational fisheries that operate in waters extending from 3 miles to 200 miles off the Alaska coast. The Regional Office also works in close coordination with the State of Alaska and co-management partners to conserve and recover marine mammals in Alaska. The Alaska Fisheries Science Center produces the science to monitor and assess the health of fish, crab and marine mammal populations and study Alaska marine ecosystems. This science supports NOAA Fisheries and the Council's resource management decisions.
